Proposed improvements are along the Elgin O'Hare West Access between Sta. 873+00 to 931+54 Eastbound and Westbound. Improvements include widening and resurfacing of the pavement in order to provide an additional inner lane as well as a 4' wide asphalt shoulder. Improvements also include removal of existing noise abatement walls and the construction of five new noise abatement walls. As part of the proposed improvements, there will be street lights relocation, installation of guardrail and signs, tree removal, drainage improvements, erosion control, landscaping, and traffic control and protection.
